Study in the Epistles of Peter

Pastor's Review:

The First Epistle of Peter

Chp. 1:

(1Pe 1:13) Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

(1Pe 1:14) As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

(1Pe 1:15) But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

(1Pe 1:16) Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

(1Pe 1:18) Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

(1Pe 1:19) But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

(1Pe 1:21) Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

(1Pe 1:22) Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

(1Pe 1:23) Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.

(1Pe 1:24) For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

- Peter sends this letter to the churches to prepare them for the persecution that is to come.
- This letter was to be passed around to the churches in the area of Asia Minor.
- Peter writes to support attendance of going to church; the apostles as well as Jesus were examples of attending church to study GOD'S Word.
- Major aspect of Peter's teaching is dealing with problems we all face and the consequences, GOD/Christ will help you to deal with all of it; testify to others how GOD got you through it.
- Peter cautions Gentiles to not use past evaluations, silver and gold as a relationship with GOD.
- You can't earn worth to GOD; the only worth is given by GOD alone.
- The blood of Jesus makes us worthy.
- Purify yourself by obeying for a pure heart; don't live in a fairy tale but be grace motivated.
- Obeying the truth purifies.
- The Word of GOD lives and abides forever!
- (Isa 40:8) The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.
- GOD causes us to be and have; outside of Him all will perish.

Chp. 2:

(1Pe 2:1) Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

(1Pe 2:2) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

(1Pe 2:3) If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

(1Pe 2:4) To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious,

(1Pe 2:5) Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

(1Pe 2:6) Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on Him shall not be confounded.

(1Pe 2:7) Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,

(1Pe 2:8) And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

- Obedience in the Word of GOD you being purified so your purification in the LORD is eternal; desiring pure milk of the Word sustained by that Word of GOD, then YOU will grow!
- Don't be a counterfeit; be able to determine the real. Be hungry for the truth.
- (Isa 26:3) Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
- If you are saved the Word of GOD will provide what the Word says; it is salvation.
- We, the priest that are in the body of Christ are able to go to the throne room of GOD by the blood of Jesus Christ, the cornerstone we are made of the stuff of Jesus, the living stone.
- The stone that was rejected is now Jesus, the chief cornerstone for a particular building.

(1Pe 2:9) But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

(1Pe 2:10) Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

(1Pe 2:11) Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

(1Pe 2:12) Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

- GOD brought the Jew and Gentile together all were lost with out Jesus, a special people to Him.
- OT is a testament of shadows and types; the NT is the fulfillment of those things.
- We were chosen only because GOD choose us out of His love for us, nothing we did.
- GOD demonstrated His love by the sacrifice of His Son, Jesus to atone for our sins.
- It is our responsibility to proclaim the praises of GOD, who call out of darkness.
- Obtaining the mercy of GOD you are now merciful to others.
- (Mat 5:7) Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- The rejection from the world, GOD will use to glorify Himsel; the wages of sin is death.
