- You can live each day with your mind fixed on Christ; GOD knows all about it.
- Don't allow your living to separate you from praising GOD, He will give what you need to go through.
- Peter teaches as we are learning now on how to be a child of GOD.
- (1Pe 2:2) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that

ye may grow thereby:

- (1Pe 2:9) But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvelous light:
- Know that you are chosen and Who chose you; every believer has access to GOD by what Christ has done (24/7); offspring of a Holy King/Royalty; special to the LORD; all of these descriptive terms are states of being are only because of who you are in Christ.
- (1Pe 2:11) Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;
- You are passing through on your way to a place not like this world; don't drift away from GOD.
- (1Pe 2:12) Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.
- Be careful to practice the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-26) in your good works for GOD'S glory.
- Choosing disobedience over obeying GOD is evil; it is your chose given by a good GOD.
- Good conduct will always glorify GOD! The wages of sin is death.
- GOD is the only One to have a right be jealous of your dishonoring Him.

(1Pe 2:13) Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme;

(1Pe 2:14) Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well.

(1Pe 2:15) For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

(1Pe 2:16) As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

(1Pe 2:17) Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

- Believers are to suffer through situations in life and trust the LORD.
- Obey and submit to the civil law of the land.

- (1Co 9:19) For though I be free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.
- Our conduct ought to be honorable; respect ought to be given not earned.

(1Pe 2:18) Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.

(1Pe 2:19) For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

(1Pe 2:20) For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God.

(1Pe 2:21) For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

(1Pe 2:22) Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

(1Pe 2:23) Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

(1Pe 2:24) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

(1Pe 2:25) For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

- Let your mind immediately go towards Jesus, who submitted Himself to humiliation and suffering for us, don't be foolish.
- **Pray always to have our mind directed toward our Savior, Jesus.**
- These instructions help you to govern and conduct yourself in adverse situations.
- The message of the church is an example of how to carry yourself in these terrible times.
- If you have the LORD you have broken thru; GOD'S grace is sufficient.
- (Isa 53:5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- No illness or anything can attack your soul. Walk in the healing that came from Jesus from before the foundation of the world.
