- **GOD** sent **His** prophet Isaiah to **His** people, Judah.
- In their rebellious ways; they had turned away from **GOD**.

- Read: 2Kings: King Hezekiah and Josiah; the **Word of GOD** was lost during the destruction of Jerusalem.
- During Jerusalem's reparations they were being taught by the priest not out of the **Word of GOD**, it was not from **GOD but from them**.
- **Jesus** came exposing that they were teaching not out of the holy **Word of God** but out their own selfish motivations.
- The same thing goes on today.
- Never play the devil short, he is wicked true.
- (Luk 16:8) And the lord commended the unjust steward, because he had done wisely: for the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light.
- **Jesus** said this because we are inclined to sin.
- Our **GOD WILL** never send judgment without mercy!
- Read: 1Kings; 2Kings 18:17-27; 2Chron. (Isaiah's prophesy)
  - **GOD'S** judgment over Israel & Judah.
  - Things were bad; what is your response to bad things?
  - Do you listen and trust in the **LORD**?

### Chp. 30:

(Isa 30:1) Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:

### Chp. 31:

(Isa 31:1) Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the Holy One of Israel, neither seek the LORD!

- **GOD'S** people still trusting foreign nations and not **GOD**.

(Isa 31:5) As birds flying, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem; defending also he will deliver it; and passing over he will preserve it.

- No matter the circumstances you're going through **GOD** will deliver you from it all!
- Even though the **LORD** sent the king of Assyria, **GOD** had provided His word through Hezekiah, Isaiah; those whom **GOD** sent & knew **GOD**.
- (Isa 31:8) Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he

shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

- **God is on fire for us.**

### Chp. 32:

(Isa 32:1) Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment.

(Isa 32:2) And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.

- The blessings of **GOD**; there is a change when **GOD** is ruling.
- When **GOD** rules, **He** will provide us refuge; we ought to be this for others. They will be protected and provisions in all circumstances.

(Isa 32:9) Rise up, ye women that are at ease; hear my voice, ye careless daughters; give ear unto my speech.

(Isa 32:11) Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird sackcloth upon your loins.

- When times are bad and things are uncomfortable.
- This is judgment time.

(Isa 32:15) Until the Spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.

(Isa 32:16) Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field.

- Now there is mercy; the **Spirit of GOD** poured upon us.
- The impossible becomes possible; something happens when the **Spirit** is poured upon us.
- We are the desert, the fruitful field and the forest.
- (Rom 1:20) For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- The Magi/Wisemen, the desert people became full when they had met and bowed to **Jesus Christ** for themselves.
- Is there any forest-making going on in you?

(Isa 32:16) Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field.

(Isa 32:17) And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance forever.

(Isa 32:18) And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places;

- (Rom 14:17) For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.
- (Joh 14:3) And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Shows the harmony of **GOD'S** message; it is the same **Spirit**.
- The **Word of GOD** is our map, the standard; scripture interprets itself.

### Chp. 33:

(Isa 33:1) Woe to thee that spoilest, and thou wast not spoiled; and dealest treacherously, and they dealt not treacherously with thee! when thou shalt cease to spoil, thou shalt be spoiled; and when thou shalt make an end to deal treacherously, they shall deal treacherously with thee.

(Isa 33:2) O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble.

- They will receive their due.
- Wait on the **LORD**.

(Isa 33:5) The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness.

(Isa 33:6) And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure.

- The knowledge of the **LORD** is stability.
- The fear of the **LORD**, your reverential relationship with the **LORD**.
- The hope in the **LORD** is not like worldly hope; confidence in something that hasn't happened yet;
- Our hope in the **LORD** is sure; a living hope, nothing can kill it.
- **Jesus** is the hope of glory; the fulfillment of **GOD'S** promise.
- (Col 1:27) To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:
- Trust in the **LORD** and follow **His** guidance.
