Pastor's Review:

- It is important that we are learning better to see **Christ**.
- **God** isn't impressed with the ceremonies we perform but with our true and sincere relationship with **Him**.
- Don't get your worth from where you are from; your worth is found out of a relationship with the **One** who created you.

The Gospel message is : (Joh 3:16) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him

should not perish, but have everlasting life.

- Do you know **Jesus, the Savior** of the world?
- What gets us in trouble is sin, disobedience to **God's Word**.

Chp. 59:

(Isa 59:1) Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

(Isa 59:2) But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

(Isa 59:3) For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness.

(Isa 59:5) They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper.

(Isa 59:7) Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths.

(Isa 59:8) The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace.

- Sin separates us.
- Weaving lies that have nothing to do with **God**.
- In Noah's time **God** saw all manner of wickedness in every thought and imagination it was sinful.
- (Psa 1:1) Blessed is the man that **walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat** of the scornful.
- These ways and paths refer to the course of a person's life: a straight path that leads to **God** and a crooked path that leads to death. (**they shall not find peace.**)
- Mercy is what is given that we don't deserve it is grace unearned.

(Isa 59:9) Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness.

(Isa 59:10) We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noonday as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men.

(Isa 59:11) We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for

judgment, but there is none; for salvation, but it is far off from us.

(Isa 59:12) For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them;

(Isa 59:13) In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.

- Justice is pursuing you; you don't have to sin.
- (1Jn 2:1) My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Suffering because of your own continued sinfulness coming before your sanctified mind; temptations come not by **God**.

(Isa 59:14) And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

(Isa 59:15) Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment.

- Truth gets left outside the church, left to prey.
- **God** will rescue **His** people in spite of their sin and helplessness.

(Isa 59:16) And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him.

(Isa 59:17) For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.

(Isa 59:18) According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompence to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompence.

(Isa 59:19) So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

- **God** proclaims that in absence of an intercessor **He Himself** will step into the gap between **Himself** and **His** people.
- We ought to be interceding for one another.
- **God** is our warrior with spiritual armor and weapons, commanded by **God**. **God's** enemies don't get off without punishment.
- (Rom 12:19) Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give

place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

(Isa 59:19) So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

(Isa 59:20) And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD.

(Isa 59:21) As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and forever.

- The standard is the cross of **Jesus** who died for us.
- All will fear **Yahweh** after **His** work of retribution.
- Forever=end time application; far reaching
- **God's** promise to the seed of the redeemed.
- **We fight with the Word of God.**
- **Teach your seed to proclaim the glory of God to future generations.**
