## ***Godlessness in the Last Days:***

(2 Timothy 3:1) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

- The “good news” that eternal life is available to all who will receive it through faith in **Jesus Christ**.
- Describes the last days and what makes them perilous.
- Refers to **Christ’s** return; the unbelieving and unfaithful people of this time.
- Paul instructs Timothy to be faithful to the cause of the message of **Christ Jesus** and the church.

(2 Timothy 3:2) For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

- Blaspheme: giving **God’s** glory to someone or something else other than **God**.
- Warning: disobedient and ungrateful children; lacking thankfulness.
- Holiness comes from that which is Holy; **Christ Jesus**.
- The church of **Jesus Christ** is holy, only through Him.
- (1 Peter 1:16) Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
- The church must act on the instructions given in the **Word of God**.

(2 Timothy 3:3) Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

- All good things come from **God**; **God** is a jealous **God!**
- (Isaiah 42:8) I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.
- Brutal; beasts are brutal...are you brutal?

(2 Timothy 3:4) Traitors, heady, high minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

- We are living in times where men seek personal recognition of themselves and their accomplishments.
- **Jesus** never sought to boast about His accomplishments, and there were many!

(2 Timothy 3:5) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

- Denying the power of **God**; ie: attending church does not mean you belong to **Christ Jesus**; especially how you are outside of church.
- Have nothing to do with such people!

(2 Timothy 3:6) For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

(2 Timothy 3:7) Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

(2 Timothy 3:8) Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

(2 Timothy 3:9) But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.

(2 Timothy 3:11) Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me.

- The place of the man according to **God** is the head.
- There is nothing **God** will not deliver His church out of or from.

(2 Timothy 3:15) And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

- The Word of **God** will make you wise.

## **Review: Revelation Chp. 17 Scarlet Woman upon the Beast**

(Revelation 17:4) And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

(Revelation 17:5) And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

- The woman symbolizes (metaphor) for dragon/beast
- That which draws the world into damnation.
- **GOD WILL DELIVER US FROM THEM ALL!!**

(Revelation 17:12) And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

(Revelation 17:13) These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.

- Symbolizes kings, kingdoms and rulers

(Revelation 17:14) These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

- They will all make war with **Christ Jesus** but He will win!

## Chp. 18: Fallen Babylon

### **Babylon: symbolizes that which is against Christ.**

(Revelation 18:2) And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

(Revelation 18:3) For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

(Revelation 18:8) Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.

- **God** brings His people away out of the judgment pronounced upon the sins; burned with fire.

(Revelation 18:10) Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

- What is a harlot? Loose, crude or obscene behavior, sexual immorality.
- A church that is unfaithful presenting itself as holy.
- Babylon the great harlot.

(Revelation 18:17) For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

- (Mark 8:36) For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?
- Highlights: merchants got rich (money); experienced great financial loss; they weep and mourn.
- They got by but not away.
- One hour = short time

(Revelation 18:20) Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her.

- The scales of justice will be balanced.

(Revelation 18:24) And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth.

- All the enemies of **God** will be dealt with, all those who sinned against

**God** and His people. (**God's** holy people)

- Destruction of that great city (Babylon); thrown down never to be seen again (v.21).
- The finality of Babylon's doom.
- (Isaiah 40:31) But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.
