Godlessness in the Last Days:

(2 Timothy 3:1) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

Pastor's Remarks: Something to think on.....

Pastor qualified his statements concerning President Abraham Lincoln in saying that he was one of the most pronounced Presidents in our times. He studied and quoted scripture and was known for using it honestly. So, although, not as developed in his thinking from the beginning he evolved and grew as he studied the Word of God.

In the Gettysburg Address he encouraged and urged the nation to "ensure that the dead shall not have died in vain-that this nation, under God, shall have a new birth of freedom"....

Abraham Lincoln called for the end of the enslavement of people in his Emancipation Proclamation speech.

What was taught to us needs to be **reevaluated** and **enlightened** based on our **knowledge** gained now. Examine yourself;

When the Antichrist come on the scene spurting the lie-it will be repeated and the message will go forth until it becomes the focus, dealing with and believing the lie he recited.

- (Romans 5:8) But God showed his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners (enemies), Christ died for us.
- (Psalms 51:10) Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
- (Psalms 51:11) Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- (Psalms 51:13) Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.
 - No one gets washed (saved) and shuts up about it!

Review:

Nebuchadnezzar's vision:

(Daniel 2:1) And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.

- The king dreamed of an image that was like:
 - Head-gold (Babylon) Dragon: the greatest of them all
 - Torso-silver (Med-Persia) Demons
 - Legs-iron & clay (Romans-Greek) The Harlot
 - Feet-metal & clay (Fallen Angels)
 - Ultimately in Revelation we see **all** will be destroyed by **God**.
- (Daniel 2:34) Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.
 - Vision of a stone cut out of a mountain not by human hands
 - **Christ**, the Kingdom of **God** pulverize them all, at no point will these empires survive the "**Stone**".
 - All of these represent enemies of the Kingdom of **God**.
 - The woman in Book of Revelation like the woman in the NT pregnant (unknown); the dragon did everything to kill the baby
 - These women were told by **God** to move
 - **God** uses what men are doing to accomplish His will.
 - In Revelation it is how **God** pulverizes His enemies.

Prophecy of Ezekiel: Promised a new heart in His people

- (Ezekiel 38:2) Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him,

- These are all representatives (somebody) of the enemies **God**.
- Note here that God says “**all**” many times in this scripture.
- **God** is saying that will be a time when these will come against Israel His people and He will use them to give glory to **Himself**.
- **God will get glory at judgment day!**

- (Romans 6:23) For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
 - **God** is doing this so that the heathen will know Him; He will carry out His righteous word and what He said would happen condemn the sinner.
 - Sinners must be punished to accomplish **God’s** word; death is separation from the glory of **God**.
 - But we will have the glory of the redeemed of **God**.
 - Lucifer will come with **all** and will not win.

- (Ezekiel 38:16) And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in the latter days, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes.
- (Ezekiel 38:18) And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face.
 - **God** is a bad man!

- (Ezekiel 38:22) And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone.
- (Ezekiel 38:23) Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

Baptism of the Holy Spirit:

- (Acts 1:4) And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.
- (Acts 1:5) For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.
 - They were not indwelt with the **Holy Ghost** at this time.

- (Acts 1:6) When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?
- (Acts 1:7) And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.
- (Acts 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
 - When the **Holy Ghost** comes upon you, He changes things!
 - **Jesus** said don't worry when; just be ready to go.
 - You will step over the race line (Samaria) and go over there filled with the **Spirit** of the **Living God**.
 - **At your house first, your city, your state...**
 - **God** said vengeance is mine said the **Lord**.
- (Romans 12:19) Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

The Coming of the Kingdom:

- (Luke 17:20) And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:
 - **Jesus** said the Kingdom does not come with what you see.
- (Luke 17:21) Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.
- (Luke 17:23) And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: go not after them, nor follow them.
- (Luke 17:26) And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.
- (Luke 17:27) They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.
- (Luke 17:28) Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;
- (Luke 17:29) But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all.
 - Noah was obedient to **God**; others ate, drank and made merry.
 - All the judgments of **God**: water, fire & brimstone were all there
