Godlessness in the Last Days:

(2 Timothy 3:1) This knows also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

Pastor's Comments:

- The book of **Revelation** is the book of prophesy in the New Testament.
- **Revelation** is a prophesy, a revealing or uncovering of things that have not happened.
- **Revelation** deals with Eschatology: the conceptions of the last things; deals with the end times, the last days.
- **Details for our own points of reference, what we believe.**
- It is not for our understanding of every detail; immediate application and that that is far off.
- What we believe about **Christ Jesus** if it doesn't have its substance in Him then you are being led by man.
- The Word of **God** fixes division, it is how we deal with conflicts
- The Word of **God** is our instruction manual for living.
- So often we attempt to marry **Christ** to the world; this isn't biblical.
- Who **Jesus** is and the purpose of the Church there ought not be any division. The Church should be unified, the **Lord** our **God** is One!
- (John 17:21) That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

You are either for God or against God, there is no in between!

Review:

Chp. 20 The Thousand Years

(Revelation 20:1) And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

(Revelation 20:2) And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

- Satan bond and then loosed for a period of time;
- Pay attention to the symmetry & imagery of this time.
- Premillennialism is dominate in our churches; Pastor isn't one of them.
- Believers are spoken of in time of judgment; the end times started when **Jesus** rose and went back to glory.
- These symbols & imageries come up with reasonable applications.
- **Revelation** says you are blessed if you read this book.
- **Jesus** isn't coming back to give second chances, no lull in judgment.
- **Jesus** came and saved as such that would be saved, we are to share it
- "The Great White Throne Judgment"

(Revelation 20:11) And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

- Throne is heavenly.

(Revelation 20:15) And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

- If your name isn't written in the book you will be judged.
- The first death everyone will experience this is physical death.
- There are two resurrections; resurrection unto eternal life and the other one to damnation.

Chp. 21 New Jerusalem

(Revelation 21:1) And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

- Things had changed; place where the people of **God** lived.
- No ills, no war, world without sin!

(Revelation 21:2) And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

- **God** has no respecter of person; **Jesus** came to include everyone.
- Heaven is going to provide a dwelling that is without sin, no imperfections, we will be just like Him.

(Revelation 21:3) And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold,

the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

- We are going to be in the presence of the **LORD**.
- The deepest expression of the intimate relationship the **God** promised.

(Revelation 21:4) And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

- Old things have passed away; new beginnings, change.
- (2 Corinthians 5:17) Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- (James 4:7) Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

(Revelation 21:6) And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

- **Jesus is the living water for anyone who thirst (faith in Christ)**
- (John 4:10) Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

(Revelation 21:7) He that overcome shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

- Adam the first man wasn't "born again" our walking with **God** will be closer than his walking in the garden.
- Abraham is the Father of the Faithful, he believed **God** and it was counted as righteousness.
- (John 16:33) These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

(Revelation 21:8) But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone:

which is the second death.

- No one in the body of **Christ** will experience the second death.

(Revelation 21:9) And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

(Revelation 21:10) And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

(Revelation 21:11) Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

- The city was a cube a perfect square, John recognized according to his seeing; he describes it in earthly terms to relate to what he saw.
- (1 Corinthians 2:9) But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.
- **God** doesn't need any of these earthly references.
- **Symmetry of the eternal dwelling place of the faithful.**

(Revelation 21:22) And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

(Revelation 21:24) And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

(Revelation 21:27) And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Chp. 22

(Revelation 22:1) And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

(Revelation 22:2) In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the

healing of the nations.

- Another tree in Eden that was guarded by an angel. (Gen. 2:8-14)

(Revelation 22:3) And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:

(Revelation 22:4) And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads.

(Revelation 22:5) And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

- **God** will satisfy every need; He will provide all we need forever.
- In eternity there are no days, months, no nights; gives us provision of mankind in our natural state.
- (Philippians 4:19) But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
- **Jesus** provides for us everyday our life is hidden in **Jesus Christ**.

(Revelation 22:9) Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

(Revelation 22:10) And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

(Revelation 22:12) And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

(Revelation 22:13) I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

(Revelation 22:18) For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

(Revelation 22:19) And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

(Revelation 22:20) He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come
